The HIPAA Research Training Course is now offered through the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) curriculum.

- Training for investigators and research staff required by the UCLA IRB's is **now conveniently offered in one location** at <http://www.citiprogram.org>.
- UCLA investigators and research staff whose research is covered by HIPAA are required to complete the HIPAA training only once. **Certification does not expire.**
- The new CITI HIPAA course is required for investigators and research staff whose research is covered by HIPAA and **who have not previously completed HIPAA training for researchers.** Follow the link to <http://www.citiprogram.org> to register and complete the training. You will be able to view and print a completion report at the conclusion of the course.
