2) Important information for research relying on WCG IRB: Upcoming change in address and how it affects 1572s

- WCG IRB's mailing address will change in March 2025 (official date pending) to:

- WCG IRB
- 5000 Centregreen Way, Suite 200
- Cary, NC 27513, USA

Phone numbers and staff email addresses will remain the same.

- Currently approved sites and those pending approval DO NOT need to update their 1572s. The IRB will be including a similar “IRB Change in Address” Memo on every approval communication for ~3 months after the move. Sites simply need to keep a copy of the Memo in their regulatory folders.
- If a site is approved after the IRB’s move but already submitted their 1572 with the old address, or they submit the 1572 after March 2025 but forget to use the IRB’s new address, they only need to have the IRB’s Memo on file and do not need to send FDA a revised 1572
- A copy of [WCG's memo](#) has been added to the IRB reliance page for your reference and addition to your regulatory binder.
