1) webIRB to be taken offline July 1, 2025

As previously announced, webIRB will be decommissioned with the full transition to BruinIRB. At this time, we estimate that webIRB will no longer be accessible to study teams after **June 30, 2025**. Study teams are encouraged to review their webIRB submissions to confirm that all necessary documentation has been added to your regulatory binders before this date.

After webIRB has been taken offline, OHRPP staff can assist researchers with any requests for copies of documents from webIRB records.
