1) CITI Biomedical GCP training for ICH version 3

- UCLA's Biomedical GCP training automatically updated to version 3 on October 15, 2025
- If you completed all modules after that date, your certificate (available inside CITI) will have a statement indicating the training was for version 3.
- If you completed some or all course modules before 10/15/25, you will need to re-take those modules in order to obtain a certificate indicating ICH version 3 GCP.
