### 2) Reminder: **the following webIRB processes to support UCLA policies 916 & 917 started July 22, 2022**

- 1) An automatic check for GCP training for research staff on projects that meet the [NIH definition of a clinical trial](#). This training check works like the automatic check for human subjects (HS) training that was [rolled out in July of 2021](#).
  - As a reminder, the [IRB accepts GCP training \*or\* HS training to meet the HS training requirement](#).
